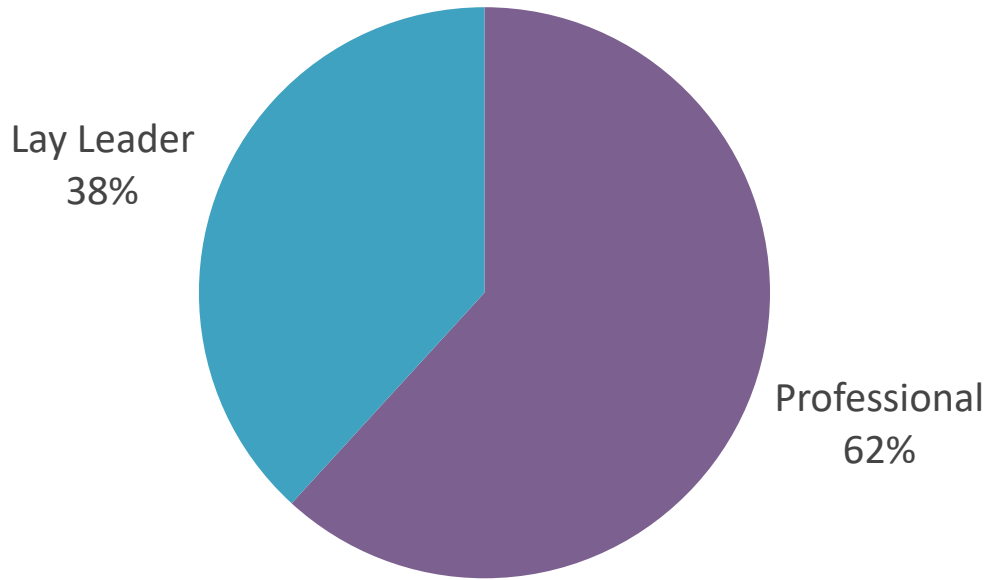


# The Survey

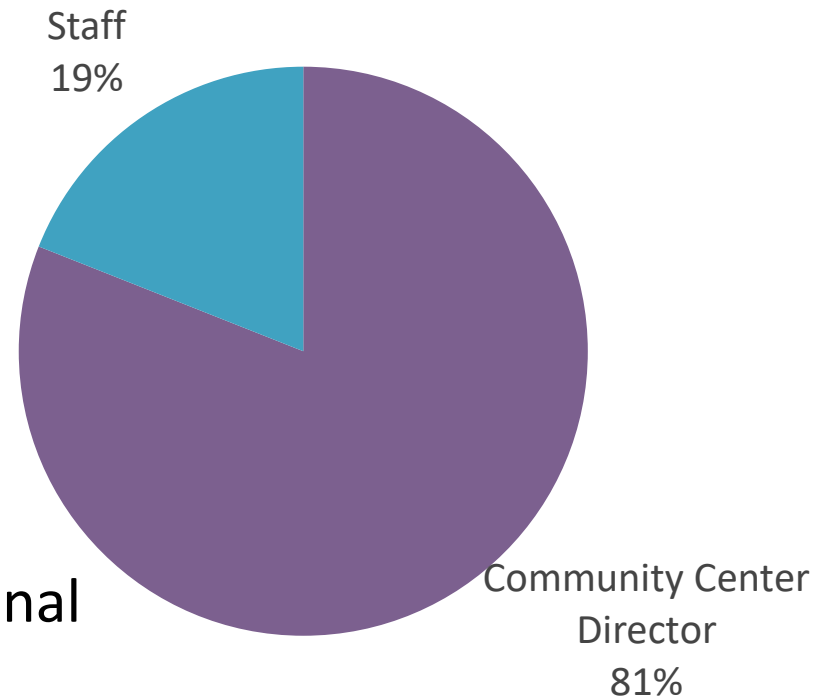
- The Conference evaluation survey was mailed immediately following the conference to 113 Amitim Fellows followed by three reminders over a ten day period.
- The survey was distributed in four languages (English, Hebrew, Russian and Spanish).
- 68 responded for a 61% response rate.

At your JCC are you a:



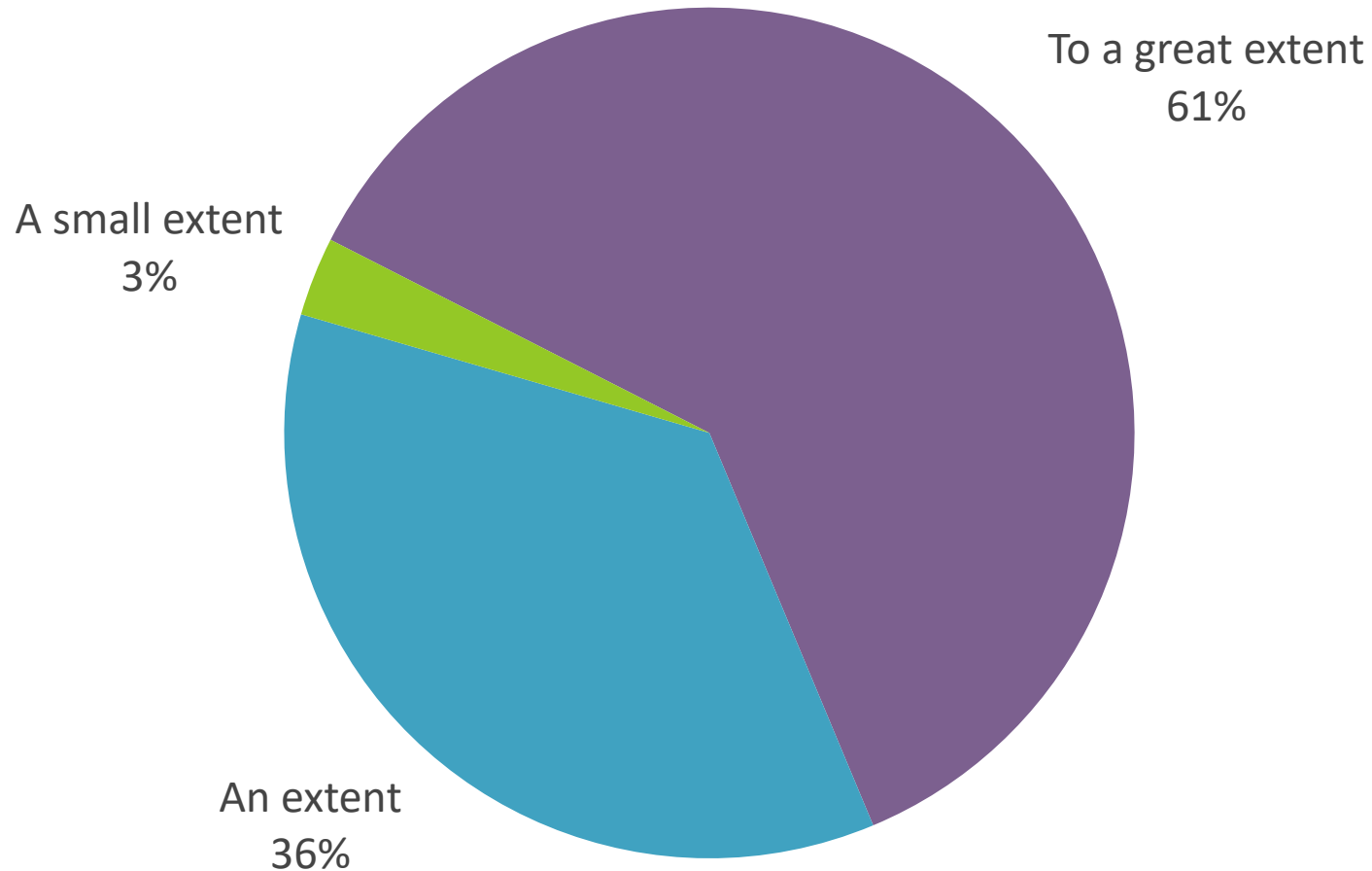
What is your professional role at your JCC?



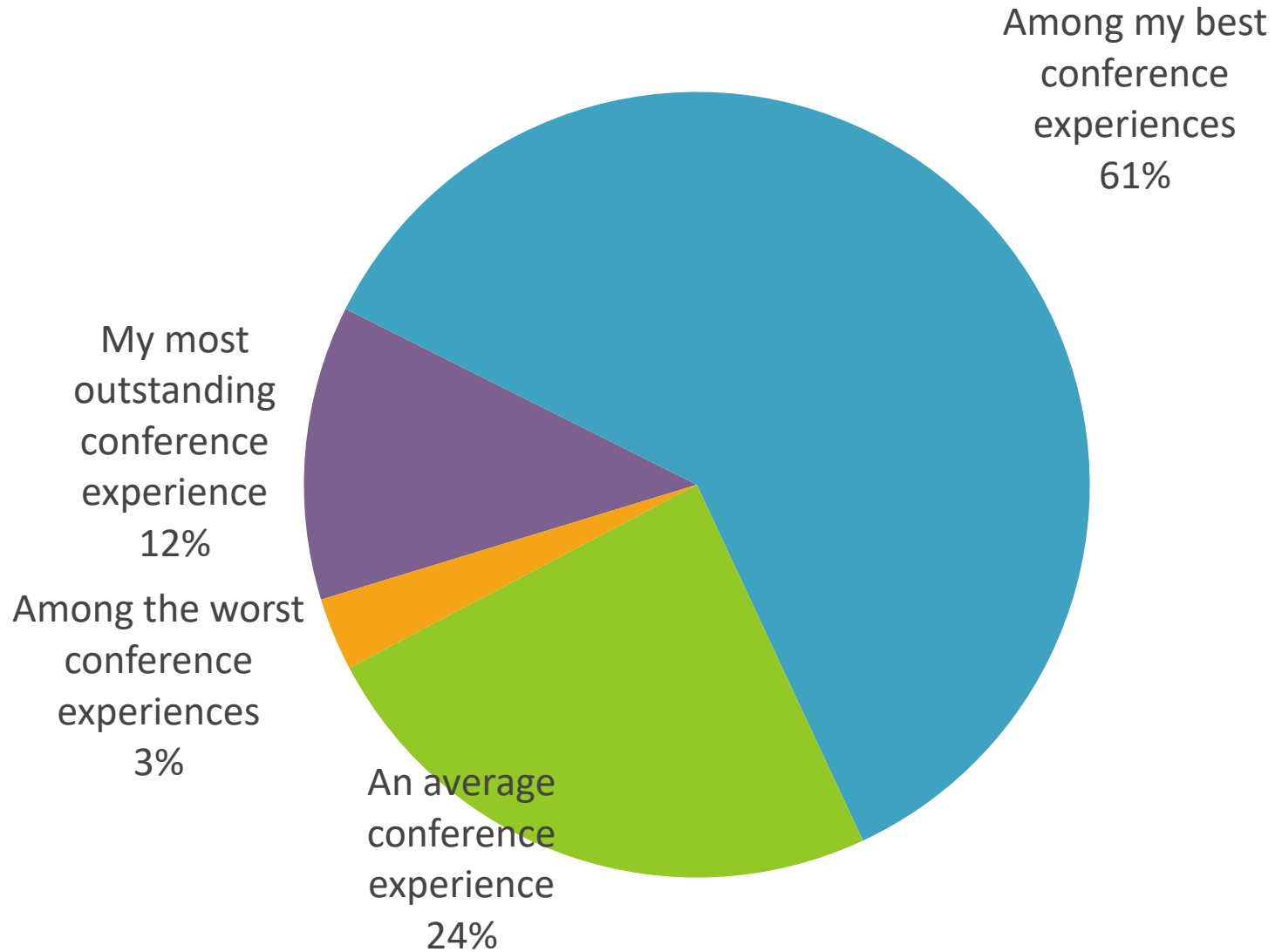

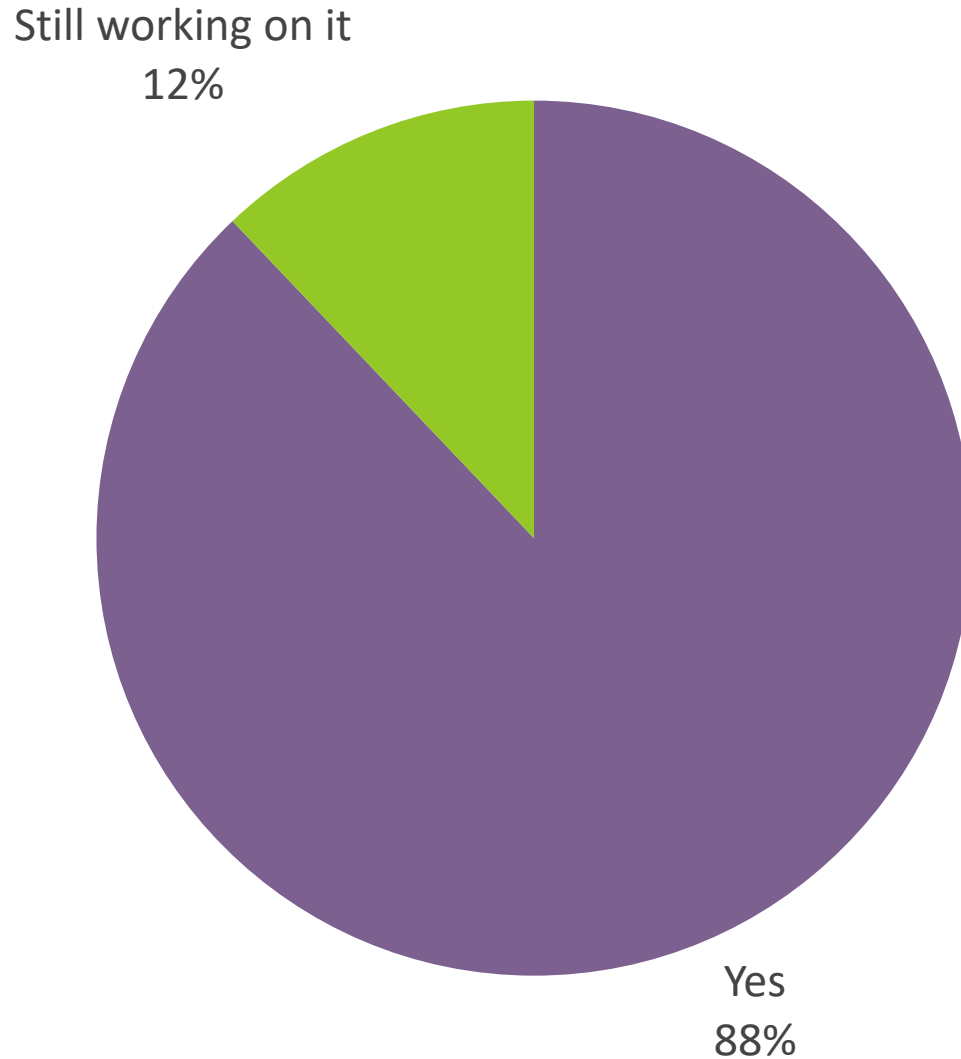

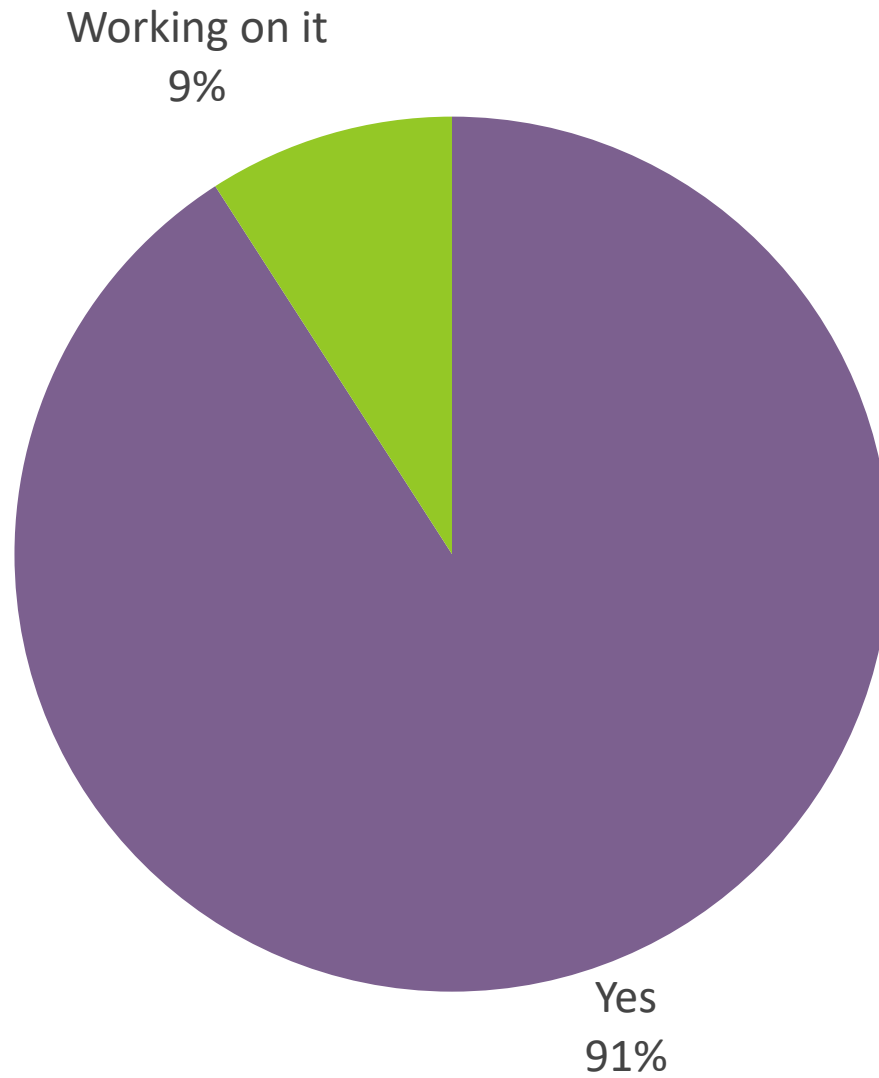

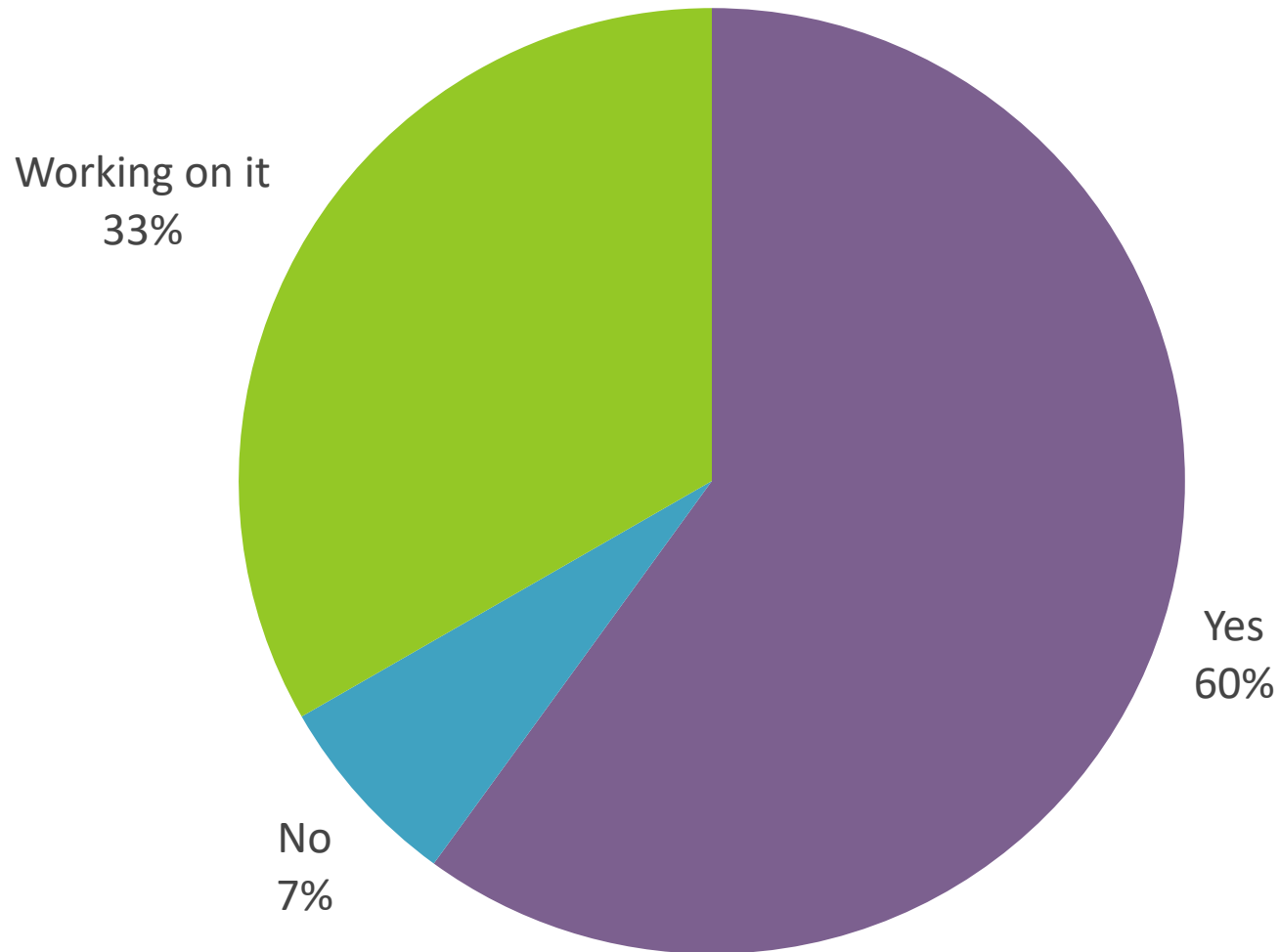
Is your JCC successfully set up with other JCC partners for your joint global project at this point in time?
